	No limit on Open Entry qualifying rounds, however we reserve the right to cap entries on a 'first come, first served' basis, should this be required to complete the event in a timely manner. 16 to qualify for the final weekend stages.			
Criteria:	Players will be allowed to play in both World Snooker Tour and Q Tour events if eligible but only where the dates for these events do not clash.			
	The top ranked eligible player from the final Q Tour Ranking List at the end of the season will receive a World Snooker Tour card for the 2023/24 and 2024/25 seasons.			
	A second World Snooker Tour card will be won by the winner of a Play-Off event to be contested by the winners of each Q Tour event (excluding the number one ranked player), topped up by remaining players in order of ranking to a maximum of 16. The draw for the Play-Off will be seeded with			

	the player highest ranked on the Q Tour Ranking List drawn against the 16th highest, and so on.
