





WPBSA Snooker Coaching Course 1st 4 Sport Level 2 Certificate in Snooker Coaching Course information & Entry requirements

Entry Requirements

Prior to registration with 1st 4 Sport, learners must:

- Be appropriately identified through the application process
- Be at least 18 years of age prior to part 1 of the course
- Be able to communicate effectively in English: both written and orally

The 1st 4 Sport Level 2 Certificate in Snooker Coaching will require each registered learner to complete an in-depth learning programme and be assessed on their knowledge of the principles of coaching and the delivery of a series of snooker coaching sessions.

This course will be delivered in four parts where you will receive teaching and training to achieve the following units contained within the qualifications, followed by a period of time where the learner/coach will undertake various tasks to complete their learner portfolio together with coaching two different levels of pupil through lessons.

The primary objective being that the coaching delivered by the coach improves the performance of the pupil and the learner/coach documents this within their portfolio.

Once a learner/coach feels they have gathered all their evidence and their portfolio is complete they can submit this for assessment which can be done by video. Full details will be provided during your course.

If the learner/coach is unsuccessful in any aspect of the assessment they are allowed two reassessments in any three-year period. The $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ 4 Sport registration period lasts for 3 years from the first part of your L2 coaching course.

Included in the course fee:

- The course consisting of 4 parts
- Assessment
- Certification
- Up to 2 results of the assessment process (if required) within 3 years from the first day of your coaching course
- Lunch & refreshments during part 4 of your course
- WPBSA Snooker Coach development folder
- Child protection booklet & info
- Resources to deliver lessons out in the field
- Laptop bag
- 1st 4 Sport registration which last for a period of 3 years from the final day of your coaching course

A black coaching polo shirt, ID card & 1st 4 Sport Qualifications certificate will only be issued once the course and assessment days have been completed and your portfolio has been certified.

Process of obtaining the qualification:

- Attend all 4-parts of our coaching course.
 It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that they can attend ALL parts of the course. Once an applicant has paid the balance for the course (one month before part 1 of the course), if for any reason you are unable to attend any part of the course, no refunds will be issued, and any payments made will not be carried forward to a future course.
- After your initial 4-part coaching course has been completed; find 2 pupils to coach (one beginner & one intermediate pupil). You will be required to document coaching sessions/lessons & complete your portfolio (all details for this will be provided during the coaching course). There is approximately 134 guided learning hours of work to be completed in total to obtain this qualification, which does include the time spent in the initial 4-part coaching course (so approximately 94-104 hours following the 4-part coaching course).
- Submit your completed portfolio for assessment by video: Once your portfolio is completed, please send this to our assessors, who will mark your portfolio and confirm which lesson you will be assessed on. You are then to deliver this lesson with a pupil and film it whilst you are doing it. At the start of the lesson your pupil must clearly state their name and contact telephone number as our assessor will need to contact them. We are looking for you to deliver the objective of that lesson and not to replicate exactly what happened in the lesson you originally delivered. The video must not be stopped or edited at any point during the lesson. The coaching session must last for 1 hour.

Please wear the correct coaching attire as you would for conducting a coaching session: WPBSA Coaching polo shirt, black trousers, black shoes & black socks.

If your application was not successful, you have 3 years from the date of part 1 of your coaching course, to re-submit for assessment.

Successful candidates will be provided with their black coaching polo shirt & WPBSA Coaching ID card. The 1st 4 Sport Certificate will be posted out within 6-8 weeks of the assessment.
