WPBSA Q TOUR STANDARD CONDITIONS OF ENTRY 1.3

Issued: 7th June 2024



All WPBSA Q Tour Europe events are subject to the following Standard Conditions of Entry which are subject to change at the discretion of the World Professional Billiards and Snooker Association ('WPBSA'). It is a breach of the WPBSA Members' Rules & Regulations not to compete to the conclusion of an event once you have entered. Please be reminded that all players are responsible for keeping the WPBSA up to date with their current email address.

WPBSA Members Rules and Disciplinary Rules

All Players: From the date of entry to any WPBSA Q Tour event until 28 days after the conclusion of the event all players entering Q Tour events are bound by the <u>WPBSA Conduct</u> <u>Regulations</u>.

Please ensure that you have read and understand the terms and conditions of entry, rules and regulations of the WPBSA.

Entry Criteria: The preliminary rounds (i.e. pre-Last 64) of WPBSA Q Tour events (excluding the final play-off event) are open to all players in good standing with their National Federation. The WPBSA may impose a maximum number of open entries to each event and the WPBSA's decision shall be final. Entries will be received on a first come, first served basis.

The Top 32 ranked players on the 2024 UK Q School Order of Merit, not qualified for the WST, are invited to compete on the 2024/25 Q Tour Europe. The top 32 will be invited as seeded players. Should a qualified player not accept their place, it will be offered to the 33rd player and so on until 32 places have been accepted.

An additional 8 junior players will be selected by the WPBSA from the Q School Order of Merit to compete from the Last 64 stage of Q Tour events. These players must be aged 20 or younger as of 21 May 2024 i.e. start of Q School 2024.

Finally, 8 players will be selected by the WPBSA from the Asia-Oceania Q School Order of Merit to compete from the Last 64 stage of Q Tour events.

These players are invited at the sole discretion of the WPBSA and the decision of the WPBSA is final. Each of the Top 32 Q School qualifiers, 8 Junior qualifiers and 8 Asia-Oceania qualifiers must pay their entry fee in full for ALL of the seven events at the start of the season. They will begin at the Last 64 stage of each event.

When a player purchases membership for Q Tour Europe through <u>https://snookerscores.net/</u> this does not relate to WPBSA Membership and solely relates to Q Tour entry.

Entry fees: Non-refundable (players have the right to appeal), & payable via the online entry system. No entries will be accepted after the closing date save for where players have qualified for an event after the closing date when at the point of closing, they had not qualified for that event.

Prize Money: Prize money for each event is defined on the Event Entry Form. The sterling equivalent amount of prize money will be paid by the WPBSA. It is the Players sole responsibility to ensure the WPBSA has a completed up to date bank nomination form at all times.

Maximum Break Prize – There will be no maximum break prize other than individual event prizes where announced within the entry pack for an event.

Rankings: Players will receive ranking points as outlined in the Prize Money Schedule within each event entry pack. Players on equal prize money will be ranked based on the best performance (stage/round reached through winning a match) working backwards from the most recent Q Tour event.

WST qualification for season 2025/2026: The top ranked player on the WPBSA Q Tour Europe Ranking List will receive a two-year WST card from the start of the 2025/26 season. Three additional tour cards will be won at the WPBSA Q Tour Global Playoff event. This 24-player seeded event will be contested by a minimum 16 players from the Q Tour Europe and up to eight players from Q Tour Global regional events.

PR Activities: Players may be required to attend PR Activities for an event scheduled for the day before play starts of that event.

Draw & Format: Draw & Format: Each event draw will be conducted by the WPBSA as soon as possible after the closing date of entry for each event.

Withdrawals: Withdrawals after the Proposed Cut-Off Point, which will be close of play (17:00 BST) on the penultimate business day prior to the start of an event (first day of qualifying), will result in the player being referred to the WPBSA disciplinary process. These new rules for withdrawal are summarised below:

Withdrawal after the closing date, but before the draw has been performed, will result in no referral to the WPBSA disciplinary process. Any Q School Invited player, i.e. the first 32 players, 8 invited junior players or 8 Asia-Oceania players from the 2024 Q School Order of Merit who have entered all seven events, will be replaced in the draw by the next highest eligible player entered in the event, based upon their Q School position.

Withdrawal after the draw has been performed, but before close of play (17:00 BST) on the penultimate business day prior to the first day of qualifying (Proposed Cut-Off Point), will result in a referral to the WPBSA disciplinary process. In these circumstances, whether that player is a seed or open entry, players will not be replaced in the draw.

Dress Code: Long sleeved shirt, waistcoat & bow tie with tailored trousers & shoes should be worn unless otherwise stated in the Event Entry Pack. A guide for professional players can be found here. Subject to the Tournament Director's discretion, the appropriate sanction for a breach of dress code will be removal from the tournament without refund of the entry fee.

Dress code around the event: All players must wear acceptable clothing at all times i.e. trousers & shirt of a reasonable standard; smart jeans (no rips) and polo shirts are permitted. Track suits and football shirts are not allowed.

Social Media Guidelines: Players are to be aware of the <u>WPBSA Social Media Guidelines</u>. Please note that a breach of the WPBSA social media guidelines is likely to be referred to the WPBSA disciplinary process. **Logos:** All logos are subject to approval from WPBSA and must comply with all regulations within the <u>WPBSA Logo Code of Practice</u>. All logos are subject to Tournament Director approval.

The WPBSA retains the right to one Player logo per Player per event.

Flights & accommodation: These costs will be the responsibility of the Player.

Cancellation: If a tournament is cancelled entry fees will be refunded for that individual event.

Non-attendance: In the event that you cannot appear at a tournament that you have entered you must inform the WPBSA (either the Tournament Director or <u>info@wpbsa.com</u>) as soon as possible as this will impact upon the draw. If you do not inform us you this will be considered a breach of the Event Conditions and MAY be subject to the WPBSA Disciplinary process.

Photo/Video Consent: There are likely to be photographs and videos taken at WPBSA Q Tour events. The WPBSA may use such images for promotional material both at the current and future events and promotions across a number of media platforms.
